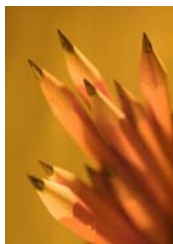

# Streetsboro Educational Foundation

The Streetsboro Educational Foundations exists to grant additional funds and resources to expand horizons for students and encourage community involvement in the education process within the Streetsboro School District.

The Foundation has been formed as a partnership of local businesses, educational professionals, and community members committed to promoting academic excellence by providing additional resources and opportunities for improving the quality of education in this school system. The Foundation's grants are designed to expand horizons for students and encourage community involvement in the education process. In the last school year the Foundation



awarded \$14,996 to projects that support academic excellence and encouraged participation in new programs and exciting educational projects for students. Initial funding for the Foundation was made possible by various community donations, and the Foundation actively participates in increasing and maintaining this fund to perpetuate distributions. The Foundation is a tax-exempt organization and therefore, all donations are tax-deductible.

## Foundation Grants

Grants are available to support educational initiatives that explore new and innovative frontiers in public school education in the City of Streetsboro. Priority is given to projects that promote parent and community interaction to enhance the learning process.

## Foundation Grants Awarded

In the last school year the Foundation awarded **\$14,996** to projects that support academic excellence in the Streetsboro School System. The following recipient programs were the result of this funding:

- **Accelerated Reading Program (Defer School)**
- **Palm Pilot Program for Student Feedback (Campus / Defer School)**
- **International Night (High School)**
- **Kids with Character (Campus School)**
- **Junior Scholars Program (Matching Funds) (High School Student)**
- **Communication Development in Preschool (Wait School)**
- **Band Grant to Tangerine Bowl (High School)**

The amount of available funds to be distributed is established by the Foundation each year. Proposals are reviewed by the Board of Directors and grants are awarded at the end of each quarterly Foundation Board of Directors Meeting.

## Foundation Scholarships Awarded

The Educational Foundation Awards funding through the Streetsboro Academic Boosters. This year the following scholarships were awarded.

- **Presidential Freedom Scholarship** - This scholarship was awarded to 2 High School students, each receiving \$1,000. The foundation's funding was matched by a national organization. **Total Scholarships Awarded: \$2,000**
- **Streetsboro Chamber of Commerce** - This scholarship was awarded through the foundation to 2 High School students, each receiving \$600. **Total Scholarships Awarded: \$1,200**

## Becoming a Foundation Member
